PLEDGE FROM THE REPUBLIC OF CHAD

Education is a priority for our Government, which, in the National Development Plan, the Interim Education and Literacy Strategy and the Revitalization of Education Government Seminar roadmap, has committed to the following for the 2015 – 2018 period:

ON FUNDING

- Increasing by 12% (in 2012) to 20% of national budget domestic financing of education, with at least 48% allocated to basic education (up from 39% in 2012);
- Allocating resources for the education of poor and marginalized groups, in particular girls, disabled children and children in nomadic, isolated, refugee and displaced populations.

ON DATA AND ACCOUNTABILITY

- With the national budget, ensuring education management information systems building and national learning assessment scheme implementation;
- Ensuring timely production of reliable data including quality and equity issues, wide and regular dissemination and communication to the UNESCO Institute for Statistics;
- Reinforcing system piloting through management decentralization by making schools and education inspectorates accountable, partnership building and dialog among all partners in joint annual reviews;
- Developing a global sectorial plan with technical support from IIEP/UNESCO for the 2016 – 2025 period, including specific prevention and mitigation measures for conflict and natural disaster risks.
